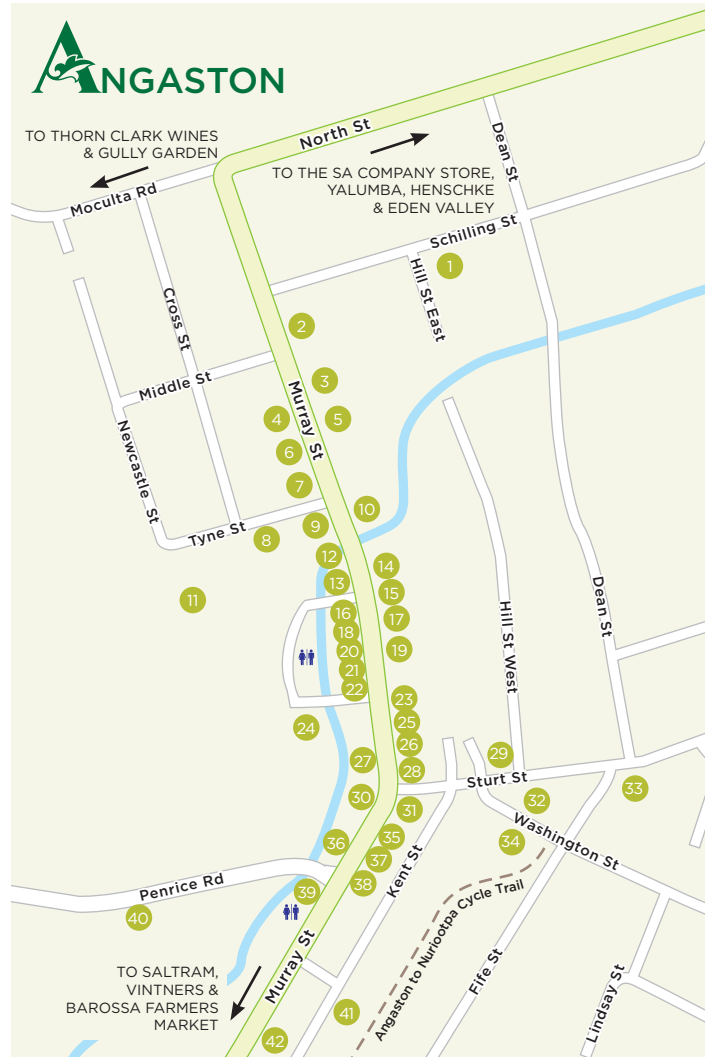


Stepping out in ANGASTON
